## SENATE BILL 2508

## By Gresham

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4; Title 12; Title 29; Title 39 and Title 40, relative to use of publically-owned property.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, Chapter 17, Part 3, is amended by adding the following as a new section thereto:

39-17-318.

- (a) A person shall not maintain living quarters on publically-owned property that is not designated or permitted for residential use.
- (b) A person's use or assembly upon publically-owned property shall not pose a health hazard or threat to the safety or welfare of another person using, assembling upon, or employed to work upon that property.
  - (c) A violation of subsection (a) or (b) is a Class C misdemeanor.
- (d) In addition to any other penalty imposed by law, a person in violation of this section shall be:
  - (1) Subject to temporary or permanent removal from the property by the appropriate law enforcement agency; and
  - (2) Liable for any damage or depletion in value to the property as a result of the person's use or assembly.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

it.
