INSTRUCTION GUIDE FOR THE PRO-LIFE NOVENA

For those who pray individually or in groups.

What:

Welcome to the Pro-Life Novena! The term "novena" comes from the Latin word for "nine". In the history of Christianity, novenas have been offered traditionally as nine days of prayer prior to a great feast day, or for any special intention. Novenas are devotions, not sacraments, so they may be prayed by anyone at any time.

The first Christians who prayed a novena were the Apostles themselves when they gathered with the Virgin Mary in the Upper Room after the Ascension. Together, they "watched and prayed" for nine days prior to the coming of the Holy Spirit on the tenth day at Pentecost (Acts, Chapter 2).

Why:

We may pray a novena for any cause or intention. In our current situation, we choose to pray for the restoration of respect for the sanctity of all human life, which is the most urgent need of our day. Our novena is a sustained form of prayer and an act of faith that addresses systematic evils such as legalized abortion, euthanasia and all other attacks against human life and against the institution of the family in our society.

Since the culture of death is fundamentally a *spiritual* reality, we recognize that only the power of God is strong enough to defeat it. We must do everything possible in a human sense to defend life and restore legal protection to the unborn, but we must never forget to depend entirely on the Lord and His mercy in overcoming the power of this evil.

How

The nine days of prayers in the following pages are carefully structured to provide a complete prayer program on behalf of the life issues:

Each day provides a different prayer <u>Intention</u>, a specific <u>Intercession</u> for people, and a petition for <u>Virtue</u> (for ourselves and others). These are followed by the <u>Prayer Offering</u> of the Holy Rosary in which we contemplate a mystery associated with the particular intention or petition of the day.

On all nine days the novena concludes with a standard <u>Pro-Life Novena Prayer</u> which can be memorized over the course of the novena by constant repetition if you so wish.

The Pro-Life Novena can be prayed individually or in a group. Group leaders are encouraged to supplement each day with <u>additional prayers</u>, which are available by way of the *Prayers in the Pew: Pro-Life Edition* prayer card, the companion to this packet.

The entire <u>novena concludes</u> at the end of Day 9 with Pope St. John Paul II's marvelous prayer to Our Lady which crowns his 1995 pro-life encyclical, *The Gospel of Life*.



Prayer of Pope John Paul II to the Mother of Life

O Mary,
bright dawn of the new world,
Mother of the living,
to you do we entrust the cause of life
Look down, O Mother,
upon the vast numbers
of babies not allowed to be born,
of the poor whose lives are made difficult,
of men and women
who are victims of brutal violence,
of the elderly and the sick killed
by indifference or out of misguided mercy.

Grant that all who believe in your Son may proclaim the Gospel of life with honesty and love to the people of our time.

Obtain for them the grace to accept that Gospel as a gift ever new, the joy of celebrating it with gratitude throughout their lives and the courage to bear witness to it resolutely, in order to build, together with all people of good will, the civilization of truth and love, to the praise and glory of God, the Creator and lover of life.

Intention: For the innocent unborn child in imminent danger of abortion

Intercession: For the medical personnel who perform or participate in abortions

The ancient Hippocratic Oath which has established the core ethical guidelines for medical personnel for centuries forbids the intentional and direct taking of human life in any form or for any reason. We intercede for all those physicians who perform abortions and euthanasia as well as nurses and other workers who support these extreme violations of human dignity. May the medical profession be restored to its own fundamental ethical principles!

Petition for Virtue: For Justice

We also beg God for the Cardinal Virtue of Justice that regulates how we relate to one another in society. Justice means "giving each his due". The unborn and all victims of the culture of death are completely deprived of their basic right life. We beg God to grant true Justice to the most vulnerable members of our society and our world. We also pray that we ourselves might be men and women of justice in all our daily interactions and relationships so that we can be effective witnesses of Divine Justice as we seek to restore Justice in law and culture.

Life Program Intention: Ultrasound

Lord, we pray for all humankind to have the grace to understand that each and every life has the right-to-life. Though the technology of ultrasound, let this tool open the eyes of all that can view the life You created inside the womb of mothers, and let it save lives by helping women to choose life. Help this initiative be bountiful in its ability to raise funds necessary to meet the needs of this ministry of life. Bless our efforts to educate and serve. We pray this in the name of Jesus, who is Lord of Life, now and forever. Amen.

Intention: For the restoration of legal protection to the unborn

Intercession: For the renewal of the legal profession and the courts

We live in a world that has unleashed the power of the entire legal system against the most defenseless human beings, and we must recognize that this structure of sin, the industry of abortion, can only be changed by turning to God. A society where evil and its advocates have grown strong needs a fundamental renewal of heart. We intercede for anyone in our world who supports or defends the practice of destroying life in the womb. We ask God to bring that "continuous, permanent conversion" of heart for them and for the renewal of our whole society.

Petition for Virtue: For Hope

We bless God and ask Him to bestow the Theological Virtue of Hope on the pro-life movement. This virtue gives us strength to continue to face the evils of this world without losing heart. May the Lord also grant Hope to the children who are under a sentence of death because of the intention of their parents to abort. May they experience God's saving grace in this life and the blessing of resurrection in the life to come.

Life Program Intention: Novena for Life Program

Lord, the protection of Life is a sustained prayer intention of the Church. Aid those facing great trials and help us to meet them where they are, to walk with them on their journey, and to intercede for them. Help us to joyfully proclaim the truth of God's love, purpose, and plan for each person as we strive to share Christ's love. As we devoutly recite our Novena for Life, let us be fully aware that changing the culture is a process of conversion that begins in our own heart. Let us go forth with confidence knowing God is always with us. We ask this in the name of Jesus our Lord. Amen.

Intention: For the strengthening of marriages and families

Intercession: For the family that is touched by the abortion decision

The culture of death and the abortion decision strike directly at the heart of the divine institution of the family. Every marriage and family is profoundly affected by the loss of an innocent child in both its short-term and long-term consequences. We intercede today for all families, large and small. May God grant His divine grace to strengthen and heal all families wounded by the culture of death and help mothers and fathers to choose life for their most vulnerable children.

Petition for Virtue: For Perseverance

We also ask God to give Perseverance to those who feel burdened by an unexpected pregnancy or by circumstances of life that seem overwhelming. Many problems are solved not by an act of violence but by patient effort to respond to life's challenges in truth and justice. May the Lord also grant perseverance to the frontline members of the pro-life movement who patiently fight for the right to life every day against the greatest odds.

Life Program Intention: Mass for People with Special Needs

God of compassion, though all of us need Your guiding Hand, give special care to those with special needs. Help us to see people with special needs are all around us in society and help us make individuals and families who might not otherwise feel welcome to fully participate in Mass and parish life. By our efforts and concerns, may they know the love You have for them, and come to trust You, through Jesus Christ, Your Son, who came to heal. Amen.

<u>Intention:</u> For clear scientific and moral education on the dignity of the human person

Intercession: For the father involved in the abortion decision

Violations of human life never occur in a vacuum. They are the fruit of society's poor education about the value of the human person. They also result from the weaknesses of men who renounce their God-given duty to protect life. We intercede for all educators and for all men whose responsibility is to uphold the truth about human dignity. We pray that God will shed His light and grace on all who are tempted to allow the destruction of the innocent.

Petition for Virtue: For Chastity

We pray that the virtue of Chastity will once again be taught and valued in our homes, schools, and society. Without the exercise of self-control in the area of human sexuality, the basic order of human relationships and family breaks down. May God also grant to all of us and our associates the grace of Chastity and the ability to witness that value to others, despite the many temptations and challenges against it.

Life Program Intention: Charity, Unity, and Fraternity

God, our Father, You so loved the world that You sent Your only Son to suffer, die, and rise for us, and for our salvation. Give us the inspiration and strength to forge a new generation of Knights and their families that embody the principles of charity, unity, and faternity. Intention: For an increase in respect for the sanctity of life in society

Intercession: For the owners, workers, and volunteers who run abortion centers

Church teaching defines social sin as any attack against the fundamental rights of the human person, the first of which is the right to life. A society in the grip of the culture of death tolerates the institutional killing of children in our very neighborhoods. We intercede for all those who administer hospitals or run abortion centers where the right to life is violated on a daily basis. May God grant to them and to our entire society a full awakening to the sanctity of human life and the will to reject the business of killing the innocents.

Petition for Virtue: For Prudence

We also ask God to grant clarity of mind and conversion of heart to all those whose business is the destruction of human life through abortion or euthanasia. We pray also for those who profit from the degradation of children, families, or vulnerable people anywhere in society. May God grant them Prudence to see the damage they cause through their works and open pathways for them to find healing work that is beneficial to the human family.

Life Program Intention: Pregnancy Center Support

Lord, You are the Protector and Defender of the most innocent and vulnerable among us. Watch over and protect pregnancy center workers who change hearts and minds about abortion as they help women during pregnancy and following the birth of their newborn children. Strengthen and guide us in our support to help women who choose life and let us be steadfast and immovable in the face of adversity as we bear witness to the Gospel of Life with our lives and our actions, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

May God give them the gift of Fortitude to overcome all their problems and look to Him as their sole refuge in times of need.

Loving and Merciful God, You create every person in Your image and unite us all in one human family. As our brothers' and sisters' keepers, fill us with courage and compassion, that we might meet the hardships of migrants and refugees who have suffered for their faith, not with silence and indifference, but with generous acts of mercy, welcoming every stranger as Christ in our midst. Guide us as Your people in this initiative as we work together to support and suffer with our fellow brothers and sisters in the faith. Amen.
