AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 1, Part 3, relative to state nicknames.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 1, Part 3, is amended by adding the following new section:

The official nickname of this state is "The Volunteer State."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.


