

SENATE BILL 1837

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 58,  
relative to prohibiting certain actions during an  
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 58-2-107, is amended by adding the  
following as a new subsection:

(n) During a state of emergency, major disaster, or natural disaster, this state, a  
political subdivision of this state, or a public official shall not prohibit, or otherwise  
restrict, the lawful operations of a church, temple, synagogue, mosque, or other place of  
worship or religious practice, including religious services or activities.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
