

SENATE BILL 1973

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2,
relative to a public policy opinion poll.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Each county election commission shall include on the November 2022
election ballot the following questions:

Should the State of Tennessee legalize medical marijuana? YES or NO

Should the State of Tennessee decriminalize possession of less than one ounce
(1 oz.) of marijuana? YES or NO

Should the State of Tennessee legalize and regulate commercial sales of
recreational use marijuana? YES or NO

SECTION 2. The secretary of state shall compile the results of the public policy opinion
poll and forward the results to each member of the general assembly.

SECTION 3. The outcome of the public policy opinion poll is not binding on the general
assembly.

SECTION 4. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
